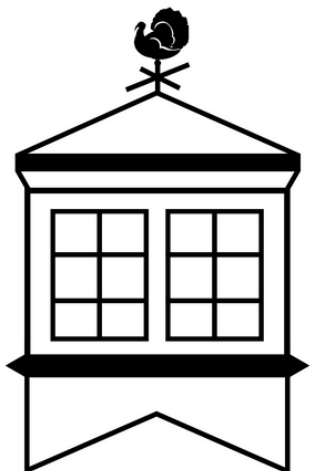

Each venue has different guidelines since COVID, so make sure to check their website before you go. We have the following passes available at this time:

Boston Museum of Science: requires a \$10 copay
Currier Museum of Art: 50% off general admission
Peabody Essex Museum: register online at pem.org/tickets, call library for promo code
The Trustees: The Trustees have 118 locations in Massachusetts that offer free admissions with a pass, including Crane's Beach, deCordova Sculpture Park and Museum, and Fruitland's museum.
