

Town of East Kingston Annual Rabies Clinic

Dr. Kirk Smith of the Amesbury Animal Hospital and the Town of East Kingston will hold its Annual Rabies Clinic on **Saturday**, **April 13**, **2024**, from **12:00pm – 2:00pm** at the East Kingston Town Office Building parking lot, 24 Depot Road.



A fee of \$19.00 will be charged for each animal. Any domestic animal may be brought to the clinic but must be restrained by a leash or in a cage.

Please bring the pet's most recent proof of rabies certification so that a threeyear vaccination can be offered. Otherwise, all vaccinations will cover a oneyear period.

The Town Clerk's Office will also be open during this time to issue dog licenses to East Kingston residents.

East Kingston residents are reminded that April 30th is the deadline for dog owners to license their dogs with the Town Clerk. This applies to all dogs, three months and older. A certificate of rabies vaccination is required as well as proof of neutering/spaying.

in 1918, the U.S. Army Signal Corps sent 223 women to France, creating the Signal Corps Female Telephone Operators Unit. Those brave women, also known as the 'Hello Girls,' took an army oath, wore army regulation uniforms, and were expected to follow army protocols while performing their switchboard operations. They were an integral part of communications during WWI and they risked their lives daily near the front lines.
