# Solar Eclipse, April 8th, 2024

NH is in a prime spot this year to view the total solar eclipse! The last time we were able to view this eclipse was in August of 2017. East Kingston has a view of around 95%, meaning that while we will not see the "total" solar eclipse; we will still be able to witness an amazing display. That is, of course, as long as the weather works in our favor.

The eclipse will begin at approximately 2:15pm. Peak will occur at 3:29pm, and the eclipse will conclude at 4:40pm.

# East Kingston 2024-25 Kindergarten Registration

East Kingston Elementary School is currently registering kindergarten students for the 24-25 school year. Students must be five years old on or before September 30, 2024 (DOB 10/1/18 through 9/30/19) and be a resident of East Kingston.

To obtain a registration packet, please call the school (603)642-3511 or email Karen Hoffmaster <a href="mailto:khoffmaster@sau16.org">khoffmaster@sau16.org</a>. Registration packets can also be found on our East Kingston School website <a href="mailto:eks.sau16.org">eks.sau16.org</a>. There will be a kindergarten orientation for parents held on May 9th at 5:00pm at the school.

All materials required are listed in the packet. You may register your child by returning all required paperwork to the school office between the hours of 8am-4pm. Our mailing address is 5 Andrews Lane, East Kingston, NH 03827.

New Hampshire State Law requires all children to have had immunizations for DPT, polio, mumps, measles, German measles, chickenpox and hepatitis B prior to entering school. A complete medical exam, taken within one year of entry into kindergarten is also required. You will also need your child's birth certificate and proof of residency to complete the registration process.



## Town of East Kingston Annual Rabies Clinic

Dr. Kirk Smith of the Amesbury Animal Hospital and the Town of East Kingston will hold its Annual Rabies Clinic on **Saturday**, **April 13**, **2024**, from **12:00pm – 2:00pm** at the East Kingston Town Office Building parking lot, 24 Depot Road.



A fee of \$19.00 will be charged for each animal. Any domestic animal may be brought to the clinic but must be restrained by a leash or in a cage.

Please bring the pet's most recent proof of rabies certification so that a threeyear vaccination can be offered. Otherwise, all vaccinations will cover a oneyear period.

The Town Clerk's Office will also be open during this time to issue dog licenses to East Kingston residents.

East Kingston residents are reminded that April 30th is the deadline for dog owners to license their dogs with the Town Clerk. This applies to all dogs, three months and older. A certificate of rabies vaccination is required as well as proof of neutering/spaying.
